

Guidelines/Protocol for OUTDOOR Resident Visitation

Independent Living Apartment Residents

Assisted Living or Nursing Residents

Testing Protocol

Visitors to independent living apartment residents are encouraged, but not required, to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test in advance of the visit.

Visitors to assisted living or nursing residents are encouraged, but not required, to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test in advance of the visit.

Visit Directions

Meet outside at any location, but ensure masking and social distancing

Must be screened, then proceed directly to the designated visitation area





- ✓ AL/SNF visits must be scheduled in advance, will last no longer than 30 minutes, visitors should arrive on-time, otherwise the visit time must be reduced to enable cleaning and disinfecting the area and the ongoing schedule to be maintained.
- ✓ No more than two visitors at a time, and visits for each resident may be limited to once each week, to ensure time is available for all residents to host visitors.
- √ No direct physical contact, and masks and social distancing required, throughout the duration of the visits.
- ✓ Pets are allowed, but must be on leashes and controlled at all times.
- ✓ Visitors are encouraged to exercise caution between testing social distancing, masks, and the avoidance of large gatherings.
