



Guidelines/Protocol for **OUTDOOR** Elder Visitation

Visitors
If choosing to visit...

**Nursing (Long-Stay or Post-Acute)
Elders**

**Testing
Protocol**

Visitors to assisted living or nursing residents are encouraged, but not required, to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test in advance of the visit.

**Visit
Directions**

Must be screened, then proceed directly to the designated visitation area



**Precautionary
Guidelines**

- ✓ Visits must be scheduled in advance, last no longer than 30 minutes, visitors should arrive on-time, otherwise the visit time must be reduced to enable cleaning and disinfecting and the ongoing schedule to be maintained.
- ✓ No more than two visitors at a time, and visits for each elder may be limited to once each week, to ensure time is available for all elders to host visitors.
- ✓ No direct physical contact, and masks and social distancing required, throughout the duration of the visits.
- ✓ Visitors are encouraged to exercise caution between testing - social distancing, masks, and the avoidance of large gatherings.
